Giovanni Azzurri

Italian Architect and restorer (1792-1858)

A pupil of Raffaele Stern, he became a professor at the Academy of Fine Arts and worked as an architect and decorator. He was the teacher of his nephew Francesco Azzurri and architect of the Barberini family, for whom he restored the Nile Mosaic in the Palazzo Colonna Barberini in Palestrina, now the National Archaeological Museum.
