

Augusto Orlandi

Italian painter
(1879-1954)

Augusto Orlandi was born in Ascoli Piceno in 1879. After the school cycle in his city he moved to Bologna where he attended the Academy of Fine Arts. After his degree he returned to the Marche and became one of the major collaborators of the artist Domenico Ferri, with whom he carried out the works on the façade of Palazzo Ferri in 1880. In 1904 he joined his elder brother Nazzareno, a well-known painter and decorator in Argentina, where he was much appreciated. In the South American state the collaboration of the Orlandi brothers continued profitably for about ten years, but Augusto decided to return to Italy in 1915. He settled again in Ascoli and continued his artistic production that ranged from landscapes to religious representations. He died in 1954.
