

Francesco Zucchi

Italian Painter and Mosaicist
(died c. 1612)

Francesco, brother and assistant of Iacopo, was born in Florence and died in Rome around 1612. He worked as a muse on other people's drawings (at the Tre Fontane, in the dome of St. Peter's in the Vatican). He painted altar paintings for S. Lorenzo in Lucina and S. Giacomo degli Incurabili; very talented in representing flowers and fruits, he colored the festoons that adorn the transept of S. Giovanni in Laterano.
