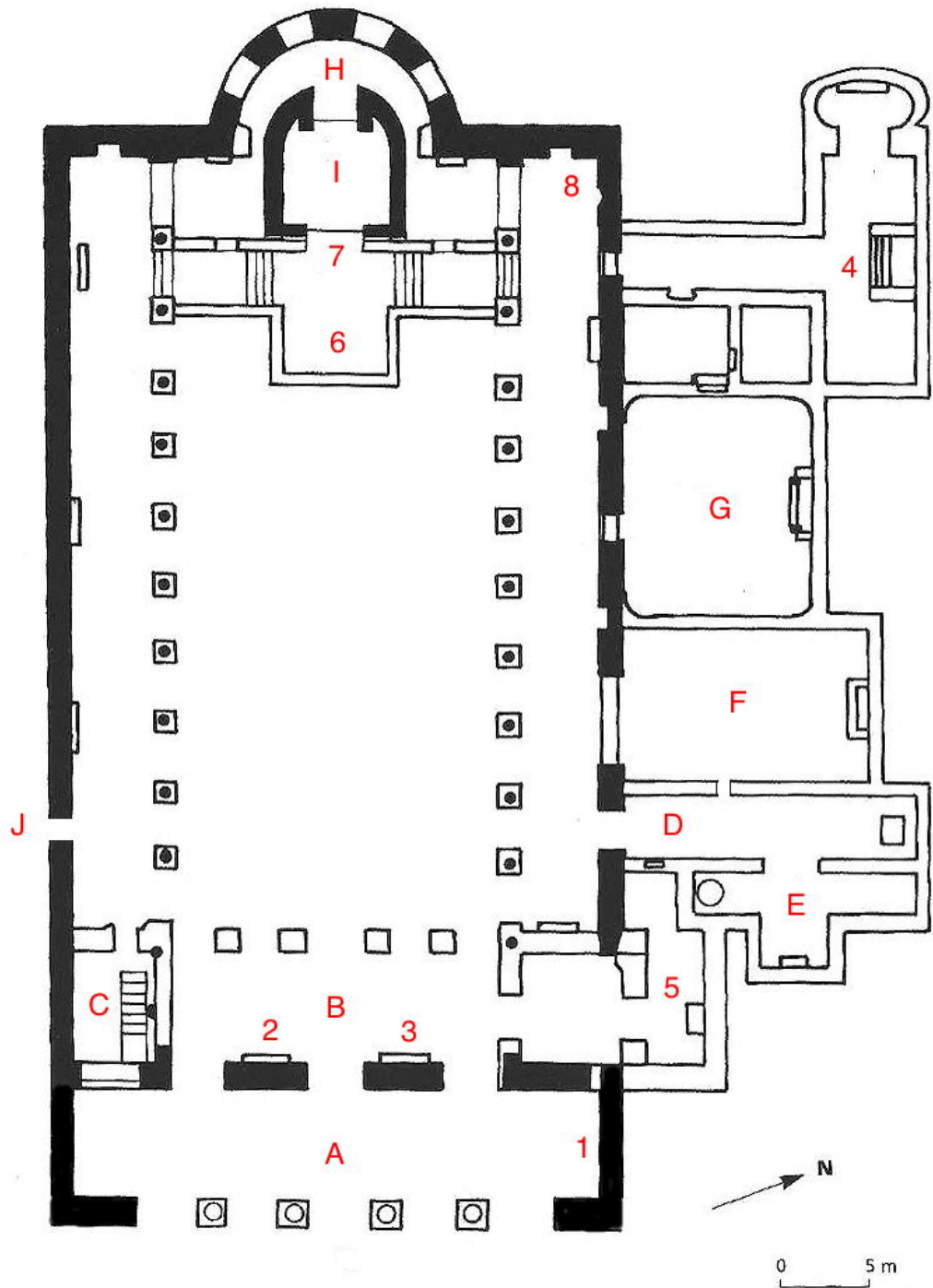


Santa Cecilia in Trastevere Plan
