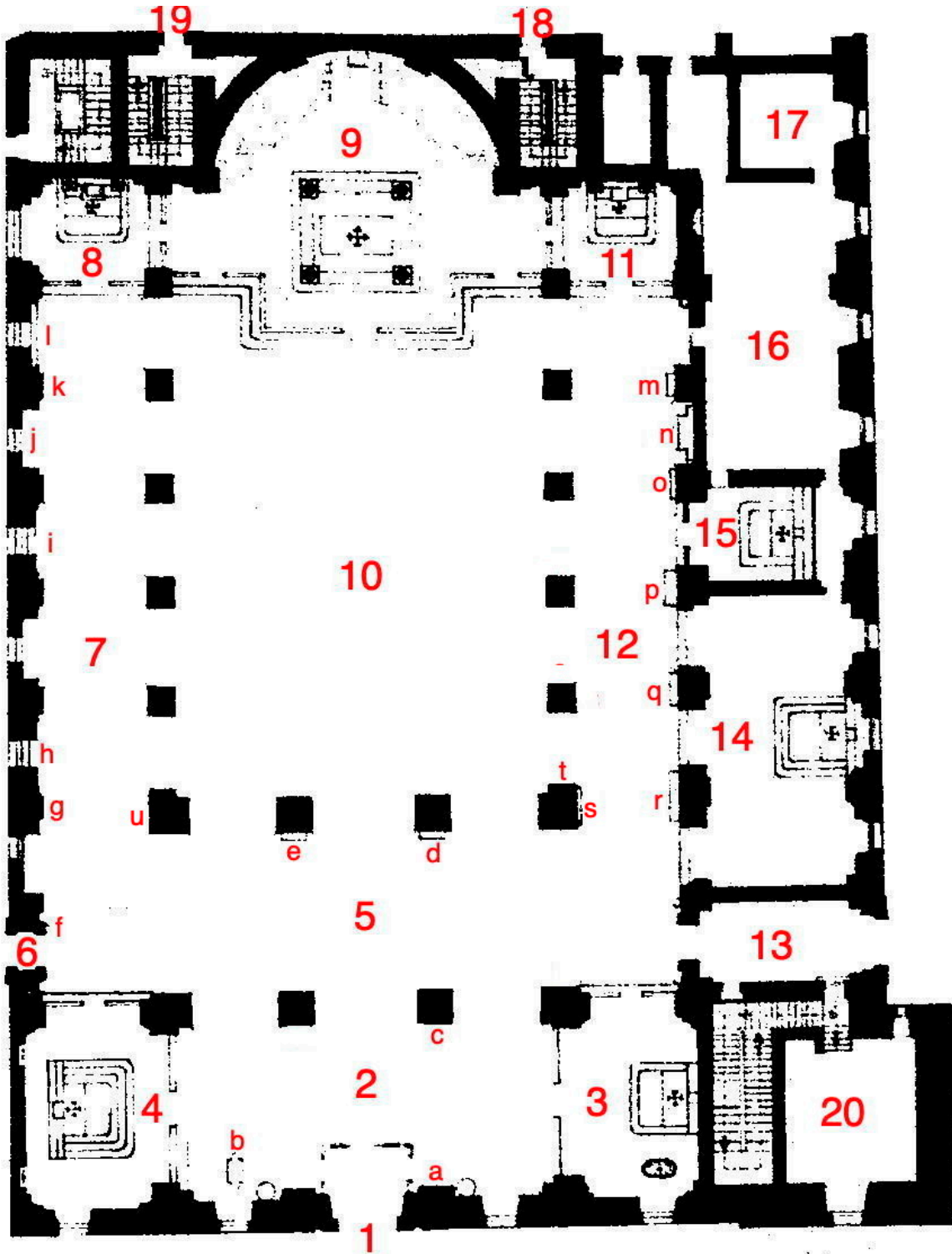


Plan of San Lorenzo in Damaso
