To God The Greatest and Best

To Michele Cauccio, who was from the town of Sant'Elpidio in Morici in the diocese of Fermo. He was a Sacred Canon of this Holy Church under four popes, known and praised for his habits of integrity and piety. He was most esteemed for his proven faith combined with his skill, as reflected in his private written notes.

Giving riches back to God who bestowed riches upon him, he tastefully embellished this chapel named for Saint Andrew and enlarged two other chapels. Also, he established as his general beneficiary the magnificent Church of Saint Michael the Archangel in the territory of his birth, which he built from the ground up.

From his submissions, and as a general rector of that church, he set up six resident chaplains, established as adistinguished chapter, retaining moreover the position of teacher in his homeland.

He allotted as a stipend two annual allotments to support girls in need and distributed pious works all over.

He died at the age of 80 on May 6, 1702.

With grateful heart, the chapter of the college of highest merit placed this memorial in the Year of Salvation 1705.
