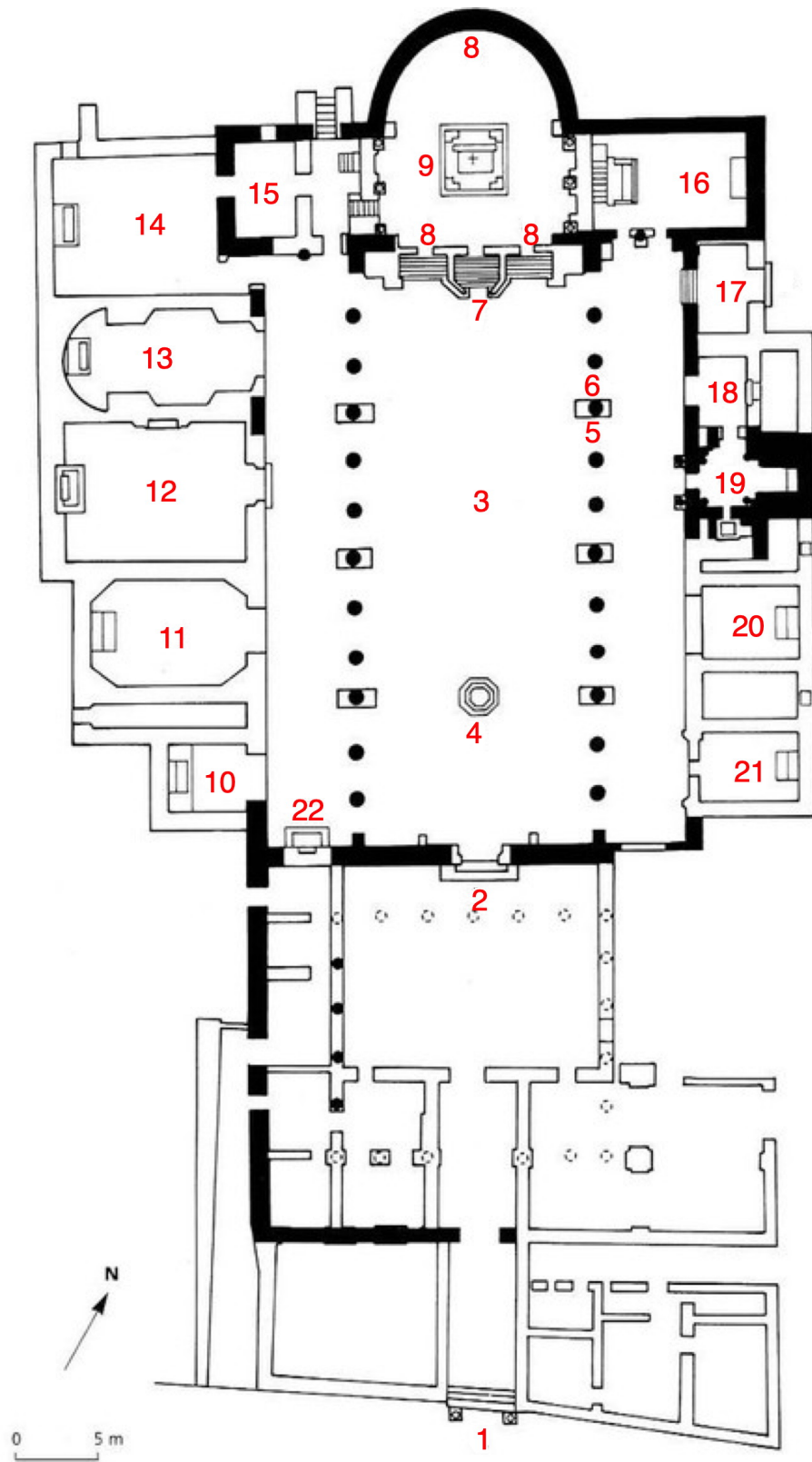


Plan of Santa Prassede all'Esquilino



1. Main entrance through prothyrum
2. Façade of 9th-century basilica from courtyard
3. Central nave
4. Porphyry disk marking the well where Santa Prassede placed the bones of martyrs
5. Tomb of G. B. Santoni, an early work of Bernini
6. Marble plaque listing the relics placed in the church by Paschal I
7. Crypt
8. Mosaics of the apse and triumphal arch, 9th century
9. Sanctuary and High Altar
10. Chapel of St. Peter
11. Chapel of S. Carlo Borromeo
12. Olgiati chapel
13. Chapel of St John Gualbert (Chapel of Blessed Sacrament)
14. Sacristy
15. Campanile (bell tower) with 9th century frescoes
16. Chapel of the Crucifix
17. Side entrance on via S. Prassede
18. Tomb of Cardinal Alano Coetivy by Bregno
19. Chapel of St. Zeno, with 9th century mosaics and the Column of Flagellation
20. Chapel of St. Pius X, given by the Cesi family
21. Chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary (formerly Chapel of S. Bernardo degli Uberti)
22. Marble slab on which Santa Prassede slept
