
Plan of the Church of Santo Stefano Rotondo



- 1 Originally the outer row of columns with transverse buildings in the form of a Greek cross
- 2 The portico with 4 columns leads into the last remaining of the above cross
- 3 Vestibule
- 4 Outer ring/colonnade
- 5 Inner ring/colonnade (22 Ionic columns)
- 6 Antique marble chair, perhaps used by Gregor I
- 7 Sacristy
- 8 Chapel of Saints Primo and Feliciano
- 9 Corrum and sacristy
- 10 Madonna dei Sette Dolori
- 11 Chapel of Saints Stephen of Hungary and Paul I Hermit
- 12 Martyrdom scenes
- 13 Altar of the Crucifix
- 14 Altar of the Madonna
- 15 Old altar
- 16 Tabernacle

- 17 Gravestone for Joh. Lazlo (16th century)
- 18 Octagonal marble altar screen
- 19 High Altar
