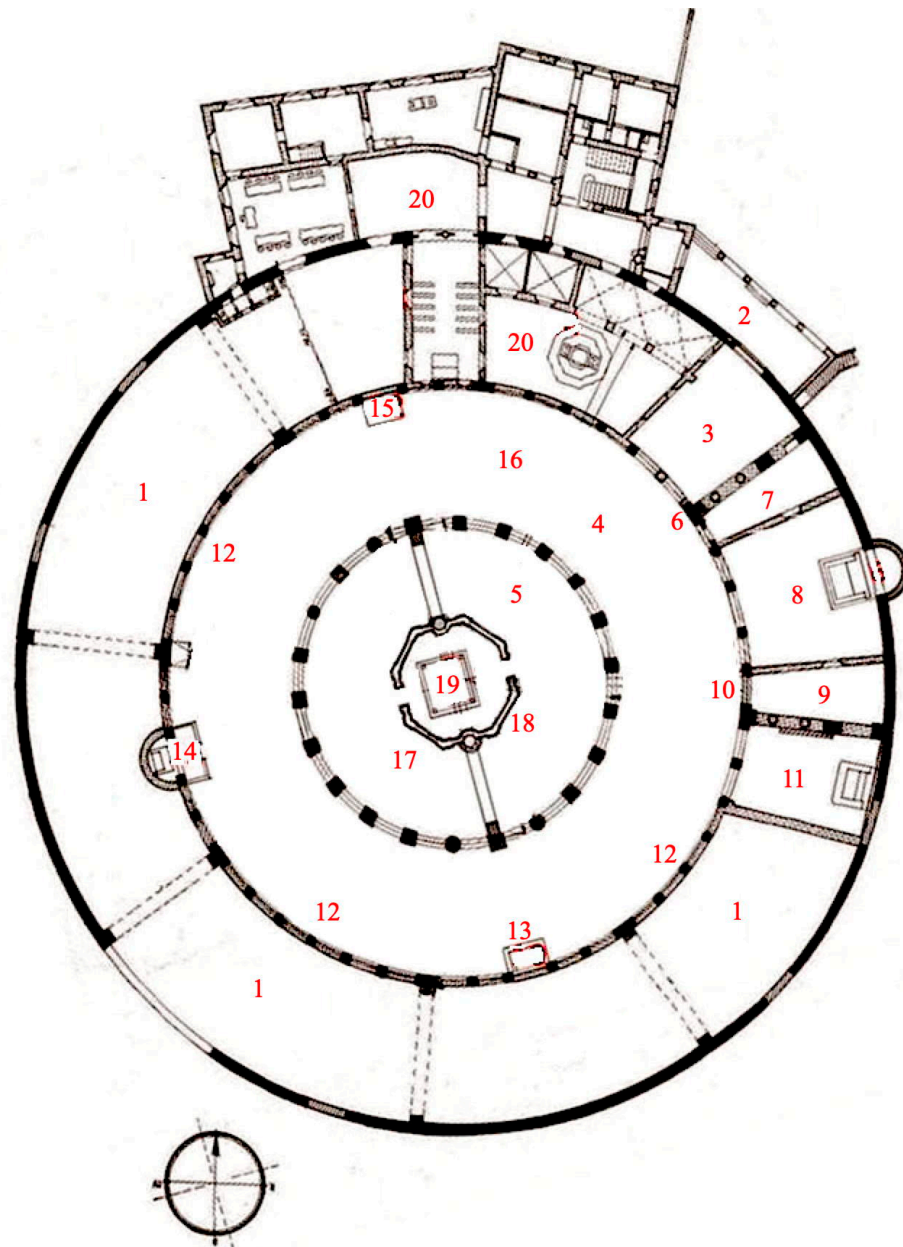


# Plan of the Church of Santo Stefano Rotondo



- 1 - Originally the outer row of columns with transverse buildings in the form of a Greek cross
- 2 - The portico with 4 columns leads into the last remaining of the above cross
- 3 - Vestibule
- 4 - Outer ring/colonnade
- 5 - Inner ring/colonnade (22 Ionic columns)
- 6 - Antique marble chair, perhaps used by Gregor I
- 7 - Sacristy
- 8 - Chapel of Saints Primo and Feliciano
- 9 - Corrum and sacristy
- 10 - *Madonna dei Sette Dolori*
- 11 - Chapel of Saints Stephen of Hungary and Paul I Hermit
- 12 - Martyrdom scenes
- 13 - Altar of the Crucifix
- 14 - Altar of the Madonna
- 15 - Old altar
- 16 - Tabernacle

17 - Gravestone for Joh. Lazlo (16th century)

18 - Octagonal marble altar screen

19 - High Altar

20 - Dependencies of the community of nuns that today live in the old monastery
